Topics of the event:

Short summary: (goals, methods, description of the programme)

The workshop was organized like one-to-one meeting with Ms Alica Ruczajewska-Tymczuk - the owner of willow plantation from Zamość. Ms Ruczajewska has been involved in the project since Preliminary workshops in Płońsk. At the beginning with no significant enthusiasm but after visit to BTC of Roland Maier in Nova Ponente in the region of Bolzen, Italy she declared further cooperation within the frames of the project.

During the workshop the feasibility was prepared based on the information and needs from the potential investor. Furthermore a telephone talk with representative of Polish Power Exchange (state owned joint-stock company, trading among other thing, in green certificates) was carried out in order to confirm selling market for BTC products.

Ms Ruczajewska has found economical calculation (in the form of excel file) very useful and declared further cooperation with POLBIOM in the field of Biomass Trade Centers in the future.
